

Fayetteville Metro Kiwanis Club Scholarship Information

What is The Scholarship?

The Fayetteville Metro Kiwanis Club offers **one** \$1,000 scholarship to seniors from any Washington County area high school, with the exception of Springdale High School and Har-Ber High School. The scholarship will be awarded annually and is nonrenewable.

Purpose:

The purpose of this scholarship is to foster the development of effective leaders through continuing educational opportunities.

Objective:

Our objective is to provide continuing education financial assistance to high school graduates with financial need, scholastic achievement and extra-curricular achievement.

Scholarship Eligibility:

Each applicant must enroll as a full-time student in an accredited university or college, including junior, community, vocational or technical college.

All applicants for the FMK scholarship shall be considered on the above criteria without regard to race, age, color, religion, gender, national origin, or existence of a physical handicap.

Scholarship Criteria:

Scholarship merit is based on three categories: Need - 55%; Scholastic Achievement - 15 %; Extra Curricular Activities (School & Community) - 30 %.

How to Apply:

Students should contact their high school guidance counselor to obtain an application form. Completed applications should be returned to:

Applications must be postmarked by April 14, 2017.

Selection Procedure:

Selection is made by the FMK scholarship committee. Applicants should be willing to be interviewed by the committee if necessary. Decisions made by this committee shall be final.

Payment of Scholarship:

The scholarship recipient shall notify FMK in writing of their college enrollment. The club will then disburse funds to the institution in the recipient's name. Should the recipient withdraw from college, payment of scholarship moneys shall cease and reimbursement of unused moneys shall be made to Fayetteville Metro Kiwanis Club.

Conditions:

In the event the scholarship recipient receives financial assistance from other sources that would constitute a full scholarship, the recipient shall notify FMK and relinquish rights to the scholarship. The moneys shall then be awarded to the runner-up, if that applicant continues to meet all criteria.

Fayetteville Metro Kiwanis Club Scholarship Guidelines

1. Application must be **TYPED** or completed in **BLUE** or **BLACK** ink only. No colored ink. No pencil.
2. Application must be legible. Please print clearly.
3. **DO NOT** use staples. Stapled applications will not be considered.
4. **DO NOT** include attachments of any kind. All questions must be answered within the application. Do not answer with “see attached.” Applications that include attachments will not be considered.
5. **DO NOT** include any identifying information within the application except for the cover page. This includes student name and/or name of school.
6. Applications must be postmarked by **April 14, 2017**. Applications postmarked after this date will not be accepted.
